

Packing * List

Sleeping

- Sleeping bag or sheets and blanket
- Pillow

Toiletry

- DEODORANT!!!
- Towel and washcloth
- Soap and shampoo
- Flip flops for showers
- Any other toiletry items you may need

Clothing

- Plenty of MODEST clothing for outdoor games and activities
- Athletic shoes for games, activities, and walking around
- MODEST bathing suite
- Swim towel
- Casual clothing/footwear for evening rallies
- NO spaghetti straps, bare midriffs, or short shorts

Other things you may want

- Bible, pen and notebook/journal
- \$\$ for snack shop
- Small fan and extension cord (no AC in cabins, but the nights are relatively cool)
- Refillable water bottle and snacks

CAMP RULES:

1. No members of the opposite sex in the same room.
2. No fighting.
3. Curfew will be abided by all staff and students
4. No stealing (including Victory Mountain, or NCW).
5. All vehicles will be parked at all times unless they are being used for planned activities (Student keys will be checked in at registration and returned upon leaving).
6. Church and student vehicles may not be used for transporting to or from camp services, activities, or meals. Adults or students with physical disabilities will be exempt.
7. Students must be present at all scheduled services and events in the designated locations.
8. No PDA will be allowed.
9. Modesty is of great importance. If the leadership of camp doesn't feel that you are dressed appropriately then they can ask you to change.
10. No use of alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs.
11. Students will respect the property and facilities of Victory Mountain, along with the property of NCW youth and that of other students. Students will be held responsible for any vandalism and destruction.
12. No weapons of any kind. (even pocket knives and lighters).
13. Although pranks are fun you cannot do anything to anyone's stuff, or anything that is publicly humiliating.
14. Electronic devices such as MP3 players, Ipods, and cell phones, cannot be used during scheduled programming, and may be confiscated if a student does not comply with the rule.

If Students choose to bring any electronic devices they do so at their own risk of the device being lost, stolen, or damaged.
